Background information on Gregory Reade, Sculptor

Reade, a bronze sculptor, creates limited edition compositions solely based on the human figure. His sculpture expresses his innermost feelings and reactions to life that extend far beyond the subjects' physical confines. This expression adds an additional dimension of energy to each sculpture and creates art that truly lives for the viewer.

Engaged in clay-mation photography and other graphic arts at an early age, upon graduating from Loyola Marymount University's Film School in Los Angeles he produced special effects for various movies, then worked for the Federal Reserve System in Washington, DC and later supervised computer networks for other major employers until European travel inspired Reade to pursue a career in sculpture.

Now residing in La Jolla, CA with his wife Sandy, Reade has studied under many internationally known sculptors at the Scottsdale Artist's School. A recipient of numerous sculpture awards, he has participated in exhibitions and festivals in Scottsdale, New York, Chicago, Beverley Hills, San Diego, La Jolla, Hilton Head, and in the nation's leading sculpture showcases in Loveland, Colorado.

In addition to serious works such as his "Truth Seeker," "Inner Turmoil," and "Chain of Success," Reade exhibits a wry humor in "Thrill of the Hunt," (depicting a woman's search for the perfect pair of shoes; "Grand Finale," (portraying dancers' final flourish;) and "Negotiation" (illustrating the give-and-take necessary in communication between the sexes.)

Reade's work has been featured in Southwest Art, Art and Antiques, Art-Talk, The New York Observer, La Jolla Light, Art Business News, and other publications.
